Memphis City Beautiful Community Grant Program is accepting proposals up to \$500 or less to help support community initiatives in Memphis that fall within the focus areas of Litter Prevention, Waste Reduction/Recycling and Beautification/Community Greening.

Community grants serve multiple purposes.

- To promote neighborhood pride, healthier living, and sustainability
- To support grassroots community action activities inside the scope of our above-listed focus areas.

Who is eligible for a community grant?

- Neighborhood associations within the Memphis city limits registered with the Office of Community Affairs, or
- Any community based civic groups such as schools, boys scouts, churches, and garden clubs within the city limits, or
- Groups outside the city limits sponsoring Memphis-based projects
- Any community improvement project! Organizations that have been funded for the same project
 for three consecutive years are ineligible; however, they are encouraged to submit new projects
 for consideration.

How can I apply? When?

- Complete and return the application by 5pm January 31, 2022.
- Memphis City Beautiful will accept community grant applications from November 29, 2021, to January 31, 2022.

Notification of award

- Pre-project approval site visit is not a guarantee of funding. This is an inspection of the site and an interview of the applicant to determine if the plan is possible as written. The inspection will be made by members of the Memphis City Beautiful Community Grant Program Committee.
- Community grant applications will be reviewed by the Memphis City Beautiful Community Grant Program Committee. Applicants will be notified by March 18, 2022, of the grant awards.
- All projects must be completed by Dec 31, 2022.
